Bill Nesbitt was appointed to the UGRWCD Board of Directors in June 2008 representing Division 8, the City of Gunnison. Bill currently serves as the Treasurer of the Board. His term expires in 2024.

After graduating from Western State College (now Western Colorado University) in 1974, Bill started a construction and remodeling business and in 1985 became a real estate broker. During his many years in Gunnison, Bill has been active in numerous city, county and state organizations. He served the City of Gunnison for 21 years on the City Council, Planning and Zoning Commission and was Gunnison's Mayor from 1989 to 1991.
