George Sibley was appointed to the UGRWCD Board of Directors in June 2006 representing Division 8, the City of Gunnison. George currently serves as the Secretary of the Board. His term expires in 2022. Sibley was hired as a part-time professor and special projects developer at Western State College (now Western Colorado University) in 1988. During his tenure at Western, he ran the “Colorado Water Workshop” from 2002-2008 and developed the “Headwaters Project,” both which continue to be popular outreach programs in the university’s region. George has written many articles about water conservation, climate change and water management for a variety of publications in Colorado and throughout the United States. George also wrote “Water Wranglers,” a book commemorating the 75-year history of the Colorado River District, which was published in 2012, and is still a popular resource today for water stakeholders in Colorado.
